Act 1. Scene 1.

Narrator enters front right holding large story book.

Narrator - Hello boys and girls, are you all sat comfortably?
I'd like to tell you a story, a little tale about love and hate, of fear and kindness, with food and beer, way too much beer.....once upon a time there was a young lady called Snow White.
Snow White is an orphan who now lives with her wicked aunty in our lovely village of **(local reference)**. Her aunt isn't as nice and kind as what Snow White is, she's positively awful. The evil wicked and it has to be said, rather vain aunt has declared herself the queen and rules the land with a firm hand.
But life goes on regardless even if the residents do live in fear.
Let's see what is happening in the village today.

Curtains open to reveal village, Idiots are dressed as the village people and milling around

Narrator - Ahh its our old friends the seven idiots, let me introduce them. We have Pew Pew, Barney, McGrew, Cuthbert, Dibble, Grub and... Dave. These simple folks live together in a little cottage in the woods just outside the village. They were part of our community once upon a time, but the queen banished them from the village, you may remember them, they used to be known as the parish council. It's the day of the morning market so let's join them and see what they are up to.

SONG 1

Pew Pew - You can't beat a good old sing song, I used to like that one called the Hokey Cokey so much, I became addicted to it, but I managed to throw my whole self in to getting better and turned myself around.

Barney - I used to be addicted to drinking detergent, but I'm clean now....I just drink brake fluid these days, I know I drink it a lot, but I can stop at anytime

McGrew - I'm addicted to welsh singer's; I asked the doctor if it's normal to spend all day listening to Tom Jones. He said, "it's not unusual."

Cuthbert - I went to the doctors once, he wanted me to get a brain transplant, I was all for it to begin with, but then I changed my mind.

Dibble - At least we have each other for support, life is so much better when you have friends, although my best friend drowned in a bowl of muesli. He was pulled in by a strong currant.

Grub - When I was younger, my friends laughed at me when I told them I had a hot date and they said she was imaginary. Well the joke was on them – because they were imaginary too.

Dave - When I was younger, I was made to walk the plank. We couldn't afford a dog. ...Oh look, there's that narrator fellow, hello Mr storyteller.

Narrator- Hello folks, it's good to see you all back in the village, but why are you all dressed like that for the market this morning?

Pew Pew - we don't normally dress like this; we're going to a fancy-dress party silly, that's what's great about **(local reference)**. there's always lots going on..... it was fancy-dress wasn't it?

Barney - yes and we love movies too, especially westerns, so we're going as the magnificent seven, because there's seven of us..... there are seven of us, right?

McGrew - I think so, and because it's a fancy-dress party, we're going as the magnificent seven dressed as the village people..... there are seven in the magnificent seven aren't there?

Cuthbert - **(dressed as a cowboy)** no one told me we were going dressed as the village people, I feel stupid now. I'll stick out like a sore thumb..... it is the thumb that gets sore isn't it?

Dibble - come to think of it, you do look odd dressed like that. Well we haven't got time to get changed now..... we don't have enough time do we?

Narrator - what time is your party?

Grub - **(looking at watch)** its at February the 30th, but we're running on village time, so it probably won't start until February 33rd.....there are 33 days in a non leap year isn't there?

Dave - Don't ask me, I can't even tell the time, I tried learning once but got so annoyed, I decided to eat my watch, that was time consuming.....anyway, best we be on our way, this way everyone.

Idiots exit in different directions

Narrator - we'll meet them all again later, well we will if they manage to find the stage again, but here's someone coming now you need to be very wary of, it's the evil queen and her bodyguard Buster

Queen and Buster (holding sword) enter left

Queen - Oh good its nice and quiet, none of them annoying peasants lurking around, lazy ugly locals, well none except that lot sat out there

Buster - yeah they do look a bit shifty, all busy doing nothing. Look at that guy, I've seen more teeth on a Halloween pumpkin.

Queen - I'll be glad when I've rid this village of low life like them, I have plans of my own, bring my own people in, people that appreciate my beauty, that fulfil my wishes and worship me
(sits admiring her nails)

Narrator - Ok lets have some fun.....now according to this story book, Buster likes to practise the art of mime.

Buster - Really?? Mime? **(grabs a script from backstage)** where in this script does it say I have to do mime?

Narrator - oh so now you want to read the script. I have the story book and if that's what the book says then that's what you must do, the story is never wrong. It could have been worse, I could have said interpretive dance So according to the story book, Buster likes to practise the art of mime.

Buster - I hate you **(put down sword and starts to do mime)**

Narrator - the book also says that Buster calls the evil queen a cow

Buster - **(begging)** no no please, not that, please no, anything but that, how about some of that interpretive dance you mentioned?

Narrator - the book also says that Buster calls the evil queen a cow

Buster - **(sighs)** the queen is a cow

Queen - WHAT DID YOU SAY?

Buster - wow.....looks wow.... I said the queen looks wow

Queen - yes well that's understandable, its actually a burden you know, being the most beautiful in all the land, one has to dress accordingly, one has standards to keep, shame them lot out there don't have the same standards, honestly, what was that lady thinking?

Buster - so my errrbeautiful queen, why are we at the market?

Queen - Oh yes, I nearly forgot, I was busy being distracted by my awesomeness. We need to see if my magic mirror has arrived that I ordered, so go and find out if it's here and make sure they know that they have to deliver it.....oh and if it's not here, then off with his head.

Buster - certainly your gorgeous nastiness, oh I do hope it hasn't arrived, **(glares at narrator)** I could do with taking out my frustrations on someone

Buster exits right leaving sword

Buster - **(off stage)** DAMN!..... **(sticks arm out onto stage)** narrator guy, could you pass me my sword, you robbed me of my dignity, you will not deny me my dramatic exit

Narrator passes sword to Buster and exits front right

Queen - it better had arrived; I've waited so long for it. I am the wealthiest and most gorgeous being alive, it's only fair that I should get to see me as well. And it's a magic mirror, so I will be even more powerful than ever before, oh yes, my plan of domination is growing ever nearer, I'll rid this village of the pathetic population, including you all out there, and then I'll spread my wings even further, soon the whole county will be mine, all mine hahahaha

Queen exits left (boos)

Mumsy enters right

Mumsy - **(texting on phone)** ...dear... tena...lady...your....advert...said...I ... could.... ride.... a... bike.... while.... using... your.... Product... Ididuseyourproduct....but ...still ...can'tride....abike....can ...I ...havearefund.... and send.
Oh hello everybody, you keep turning up don't you? I'm sorry I didn't notice you all sat there, I was on my mobile phone, aren't they marvellous. Although there was this one time that I did take a rather rude selfie of myself and I accidentally sent it to all my friends in my contact list..... it cost me a fortune in stamps.
Ooooh thank you, I do appreciate sympathetic laughter.
But let me introduce myself, I'm Mrs Duck, but you can call me Mumsy. Well you all look like a friendly crowd, so here's what we'll do, whenever I come on, I'll shout hello everybody, and you answer hello Mumsy, shall we try?.....Hello everybody **(hello Mumsy)**.....What was that? Have you all taken a vow of silence? Let's try again....Helloooooooo everybody **(hello Mumsy)**.....ooh that's better, we seem to have woken you all up.
I'm looking for my son Donald, Donald Duck, yes you heard it, Donald Duck, they've no imagination these script writers..... anyway, we both work for the evil queen, I'm her house maid and he's the game keeper. You'll know him when you see him, he dresses all in red....

Donald enters left looking creeping along the ground

Mumsy - Do tell me if you see him.....

(he's behind you)

Mumsy - What have you seen him.....he's where?behind me?
Are you sure? **(Turns round but can't see him)**
He's not behind me
(Oh yes he is)
Oh no he isn't
(Oh yes he is)
Oh no he isn't
(Oh yes he is) (Turn round and see Donald)
There you are Ducky, what on earth are you doing?

Donald - Oh hi mumsy, please don't call me Ducky, you know I don't like it. Anyway you know me, I never stop working, I'm looking for vermin.

Mumsy - Vermin? You won't find any there, they all live in **(local reference)**.

Snow White enters right holding bags pretending to have a conversation with someone off stage

Donald - Look mum, it's that beautiful Snow White **(sighs)** ahhh she's so lovely

Mumsy - Stop that, you're drooling again. But yes, she is a nice girl, always says the sweetest things

Snow - **(talking to off stage)** oh get lost, stuff you, you old trollop.

Mumsy - well most of the time she says the sweetest things

(snow turns to see mumsy)

Snow - oh hello Mumsy, hi Donald, I didn't see you both there

Donald - **(goes all shy)** hello Snow, **(giggles)** hell...o...snow, hee hee that rhymes

Mumsy - For god's sake Ducky, get a grip of yourself no no, on second thoughts, don't, we're in public.... hello young Miss White, how are you this morning?

Snow - I'm good thank you, just out for my daily stroll and do a few errands, we are so lucky to live in such a beautiful area

Donald - I was wondering Snow, would you like some..... err company on your walk? I'd love to escort you if you'll allow me

Mumsy - Oh I had an escort once, I accidentally filled it up with diesel.....he died

Snow - I'm sorry Donald, I couldn't possibly allow that, besides which, I'm sure you have lots to do

Donald - you mean because you're related to the queen and I'm just a servant of hers?

Snow - Yeah, lets go with that reason

Donald - I won't always work as a game keeper, I have dreams you know

Mumsy - Yes we all know about them dreams of yours, but you'll have to excuse us Miss White, I need to get Ducky's, I mean Donald's, lunch for him, come along my wee Ducky poo's

Donald - Muuuuum, don't call me that, not in front of Snow, it's embarrassing.

Mumsy - You'll always be my wee boy. You know Miss White, he's so dependent on his dear old Mumsy, he can't even remember to dress properly some mornings, I'm always saying Donald, where's your trousers?
He's so forgetful, he could even arrange his own surprise party.

Snow - Don't worry Donald, we all have our little quirks and faults. Even me, I...I...oh who am I kidding, I'm perfect in every way, otherwise this story wouldn't work.

Mumsy - yes you are my dear, now please excuse us, we really must be on our way, bye bye everybody

Mumsy and Donald exit right

Snow - Oh dearest Donald is a love, I like him so much, but my aunty, the evil queen, has forbidden me from seeing anyone romantically and has said she'll have Buster deal with anyone showing interest in me. So, I have to pretend not to like him, to protect him. I hate living with the evil queen, she makes life horrible for me. But it's all I have, for now anyway, I dream of breaking away and being independent, my time will come one day.

Queen enters left

Queen - so there you are my girl.....Snow, what have I told you about talking to the locals and peasants. Look at them, someone should kick them out and replace them with human beings. People like us drink from the fountain of beauty, they **(points to audience)** just gargle with it.

Snow - why are you always so mean? You have everything anybody could ever want or need, you have money and beauty and we live within a great community. Do you think that maybe you have hidden issues? Would talking and sharing your vulnerable concerns help you to find inner peace? Unburden yourself from so much anger and hatred

Queen - Shut up you tart. I don't hate them lot out there. I don't care enough about them to hate them. Now, did you get all the shopping I asked you to get?

Snow - **(sighs)** yes aunty, its all here, I have your wine, laundry, wine, groceries, wine, new towels andoh yeah, some wine

Queen - good good, now trot on home and get it all put away, before you run my bath. I need you to race home so that you can have a coffee ready for me, come on MOVE IT!

Both exit right

Curtains close

PantoScripts Perusal

Scene 2

Narrator - Now that you've met all the villagers, well the ones relevant to the story anyway, it's time we carried on with the plot. Lets see where we have got up to..... ah yes here we are, chapter 2.

Now as you will know, the original story had seven dwarves, but these days that's not politically correct, and besides which, when we had the first read through with the script, we found we had one Doc, two grumpy's and way too many dopey's.

We do have a Snow White though, she's a lovely girl, well her character is anyway. She loves Donald but she must hide her feelings for him.... Donald however, wants the whole world to know his love for Snow White, the soppy sod. Unfortunately, the evil queen won't allow it and she has Buster to enforce her demands on all who cross her.

And of course we have the seven village idiots, who by now have returned to their little cottage in the woods, but next we will soon find ourselves in the residence of the evil queen, who as we speak, is waiting for the delivery of her new magic mirror.

So, let's re-join our tale and see what's new in the palace.

Curtains open to reveal castle scene with mirror covered on left of stage

Queen enters right

Queen - Oh boy, am I glad to be back home, that market is the pits, all them lowly people going about their sad little lives.....(**sees mirror**) ha ha, my new magic mirror has arrived. I can't wait to see it

Queen uncovers mirror

Queen - Arrgh, that's not my reflection is it?..... is it? Wow I need some work done.

Mirror - If you wanted to see your reflection, you should have purchased a normal mirror. I am a magic mirror, I can provide you with any information known to mankind. My name is Alexa...

(**Looks to off stage**) I can't believe you gave me a girl's name. Do the panto they said, it'll be fun they said, it'll be your big break they said.

Queen - Stop your moaning. You got a part, didn't you?

Mirror - My top half did.

Queen - Apparently there wasn't a part small enough for your bottom half.

Mirror - So what can I help you with?

Queen - This is so exciting, lets see..... Alexa, who is the fairest in all the land?

Mirror - Not you that's for sure, for the answer you need to look at another, one that goes by the name of Snow White

Queen - WHAT!!!! How dare you, I'm the most beautiful woman alive.

Mirror - I'm sorry you don't like my answer, but I cannot lie, I have to tell the truth. At least you're not as ugly as that woman out there on the 4th row....Hey, madam, if I throw a stick, would you leave?

Queen - Grrrr I'm so angry **(Goes to break mirror)**

Mirror - Easy tiger, I wouldn't break me if I was you. I'm a magic mirror remember. If you break me, then I'll be destroyed, that's true, but you'll be condemned to replace me. That's how I got stuck in here, I broke a magic mirror in a fit of rage when I was fired from my last job.

Queen - What happened?

Mirror - I got sacked from a factory making calendar's, all I did was take a few days off

Queen - So if I break you, I have to take your place? Oh that's not good, I can't see myself doing that. What's it like being stuck in there?

Mirror - it's so boring, but at least you get time to *reflect* on your past life.

Queen - Well I'm alive now! And I want to be the fairest in the land, what can I do?

Mirror - It's not my place to offer advice, but..... if something was to happen to Snow White....

Queen - then I WOULD be the most beautiful, oh Alexa, I like your thinking, I got a feeling, you and I could become good friends, very good friends.

Mirror - **(Sarcastically)** oh whoopee, I can hardly contain myself

SONG 2

Queen - thank you Alexa for your help, I have some scheming to do, I'll be back when I need your help

Queen exits left
Mumsy enters right

Mumsy - Oh hello everyone **(hello mumsy)**..... Oh you are good, Ooooooh is that one of them magic mirrors? Hello mirror, can I ask you anything?

Mirror - if you must, how can I help you sir? Madam, I meant madam, sorry.

Mumsy - tell me, does my bum look big in this outfit?

Mirror - Be fair love, this is a small hall..... my dear madam, you're the reason why they had to invent double doors..... If you jumped up into the air, you'd get stuck

Mumsy - huh, how rude

Mirror - don't stop me now, I'm just getting warmed up, I've got loads more

Mumsy - Whatever mirror minger, when I heard there was a magic mirror here, I thought it was one of those funny ones at the fair that make you look slim, what are they called?

Mirror - A miracle?

Mumsy - Hmmm, Alexa, how do I turn you off?

Mirror - Try walking around with no clothes on

Dame frowns at mirror, Donald enters from right

Donald - Hi mumsy

Mumsy - Oh hello my little Ducky, what are those funny mirrors at the fair called that make you look slim?

Donald - A miracle?

Mumsy - Oh you cheeky boy. Anyway, you look very pleased with yourself, a proper little *happy* ducky.

Donald - I'm just thinking back to when we were in the market and I saw.....(***giggles***) I saw Snow White there, she said hello to me

Mumsy - yes, I was there too you *dopey* Ducky. you really do like that girl, don't you? Girls like that want to be wooed

Donald - She can be as wooed as she likes with me, she's beautiful.....I want to marry her one day, but what chance do I have with a girl like Snow White?

Mumsy - Get your head out of the clouds you little love-struck cupid, you really are a *bashful* Ducky, aren't you? You'll find your true love one day, someone like your dear old mumsy.

Donald - Oh god I hope not, I'll be a *grumpy* Ducky then..... let me ask the mirror, Alexa, will Snow white ever love me?

Mirror - You'll have more luck winning a tug of war against an elephant, using only your little toe

Donald - Whenever I see her, I get a tingling all over

Mirror - That's just common sense leaving your body. Trust me, I know all there is to know about love, before I ended up in this mirror, I was a real hit with the ladies, one date with me always left them with a burning sensation, no wait that's not right, I meant before they saw me again, they were itching to..... damn it, not itching ... no I didn't mean itching..... I'll just shut up.

Donald - Why have you never remarried Mumsy?

Mumsy - When someone asks me if I'm seeing anyone, I automatically assume they're talking about a psychiatrist.

Queen and Buster enter left

Queen - Boy there, I have a job for you..... I need you and Buster to escort my niece Snow, into the woods, I need her to pick some flowers for the house

Donald - Certainly my Queen, but the woods aren't dangerous

Buster - they are when I'm in them

Mumsy - Ohh I say, I do like a dangerous man

Buster - you wouldn't know it to look at me, but I used to be a weak man

Mumsy - if you were with me, I'd make you a daily man, you handsome creature

Queen - Mumsy, if you laid on the beach, even the tide wouldn't take you..... Mumsy, send for Snow, and you two need to prepare for your errand, come on people, you all have jobs to do, so get on with it....NOW

Mumsy exits left

Donald and Buster exit right

Queen - Alexa, I took your advice, I'm having Snow White hahaha removed, in the woods. Soon I will be the fairest in all the land.

Mirror - Very wise your majesty. Our minds came together, we made a plan and..... well, let's just say it's a classic case of match, hatch anddispatch..... Tell me my queen, have you ever been romantically involved?

Queen - I have indeed, my last boyfriend left because he couldn't handle my OCD

Mirror - were you upset?

Queen - not at all, I just told him to close the door five times on his way out.....these days I'm more fussy about who I let fall in love with me

Mirror - You don't just have any old Tom, Dick or Harry then?

Queen - No no, I've never had any Tom's or Harry's

Snow enters left

Snow - You called for me my queen.

Queen - yes, yes my dear girl, I need you to run an errand. I want you to go into the woods to pick some flowers for the lounge, Donald and Buster will escort you.

Snow - Of course I'll go, but I don't need help. The woods are safe and I enjoy walking in there alone, the woodland animals are so cute.

Queen - No you mustn't go alone, I insist they accompany you, they will be waiting for you at the gates of the castle. Have fun my dear, goodbye..... **(turns to audience)** and good riddance

Queen exits left

Snow - How strange, its not like the queen to be so concerned about my safety, perhaps she's realised how awful she has been to people and wants to be a better person..... yeah and pigs might fly.. Anyway, whatever the reason is, I'd best be on my way, see you all later.

Snow exits right

Curtains close

Scene 3

Narrator enters front right

Narrator - Chapter 3, our beautiful Snow White is on her way to the woods with Donald and the evil Buster. The poor maid thinks her little errand is an innocent trip to pick flowers for her majesty the wicked queen.

What the poor girl doesn't realise, is that Buster has been told that she mustn't return home, she is to be killed, and to make the plan even more devilish, Buster has been instructed to ensure that Donald has to do the horrible task. He is to murder our poor Snow White and return home with her hair as proof that the job has been completed.

How will Donald react to such a terrible request, it's clear how he feels for the young lady. The situation is very bad indeed, What will become of Snow White? How will Donald be able to keep her safe? How will Buster get through life being so stupid? Once when he was told it was chilly outside, he ran back indoors to get a spoon and some nacho's..... He's the only person I know that nearly died from drinking milk..... the cow fell on him.

He's so stupid that one night he thought his foot was sticking out of the end of the bed, so he got out to have a look.

Oooh I could go on all night, but let's re-join our tale and see what transpires in the woods.

Curtains open to reveal woods. Rabbits are sat on stage

Rabbit 1 - Nice here innit?

Rabbit 2 - Yeah, always liked it here, it's a shame Harvey is no longer with us, he liked it here too

Rabbit 3 - Poor old Harvey, he was one crazy rabbit

Rabbit 1 - What happened to him?

Rabbit 3 - He had a cheese toasted sandwich on Monday, a ham one on Tuesday

Rabbit 2 - A corned beef one on Wednesday and baked bean one on Thursday

Rabbit 3 - He died on Friday from mixing his toasties

Rabbit 1 - That is a shame, I liked old Harvey

Rabbit 3 - it's a pity he had to miss this panto, he loved panto's

Rabbit 1 - I know, it's because at the end they all live happily ever after

Rabbit 2 - I like how you've done your fur; it looks so soft

Rabbit 1 - thank you, I use a *hare* brush

Rabbit 2 - Who's that rabbit out there?

Rabbit 3 - which rabbit? I can't see a rabbit, all I see is the audience

Rabbit 1 - Oh yeah, I see her, that one there with big ears and buck teeth and has whiskers on her top lip

Rabbit 3 - Hey, that's my mum

Pew Pew, Barney, McGrew. Cuthbert enter right

All Idiots - **(Singing)** Hey ho, hey ho, in the woods we go, we've been to the pub and had some grub, hey ho hey ho

Pew Pew - Nearly home my fellow friends, you can't beat a lovely brisk walk in the woods

Barney - it certainly helps to clear the mind and focus your attention on nature

McGrew - Some of us, mentioning no names **(points to Cuthbert)** can't focus on anything for too long

Cuthbert - My attention span isOh look, it's skippy the rabbit

Pew Pew - Why do you call a rabbit skippy? Surely you should call it hoppy.

McGrew - if you crossed a rabbit with a chicken, would it shout hop a doodle do?

Barney - I use to run a dating website for chickens. It wasn't my normal job, I just did it to make hens meet

Cuthbert - I've always wanted a pet rabbit, and I said that if I ever did get one, then I would call it Skippy

Pew Pew - Well take that one then, it looks friendly enough

Rabbit 1 - PET!!!!..... never, not a chance

Rabbit 2 - no way, remember what happened to our friend Stu? He was taken as a pet

Rabbit 3 - Yeah, and he ended up being a stew, time we hopped it.

Rabbits exits left

Cuthbert - Oh they're leaving, guess I'll never have a pet rabbit after all

McGrew - no room at the cottage anyway, it's crowded enough with seven of us living there

Barney - I suppose so, we couldn't feed a pet anyway, there's only ever just enough dinner for us, talking of which, I hope the others have nearly finished it, I'm starving.

Pew Pew - They better have, that's why they left the pub early, its their turn to cook.

Cuthbert - Yes it is, and we're supposed to be collecting fire wood on our way home, so keep looking

McGrew - Shouldn't be difficult, we're in the woods, surrounded by trees. I dated a tree once, I met it on a dating site called Timber

All laugh

Barney - haha, did you have to *log* in?

Stop laughing and stare at Barney

Pew Pew - I like that tree that sings, he's called Spruce Springsteen

All laugh

Barney - haha yes, he is very *poplar*

Stop laughing and stare at Barney

McGrew - Why was the tree stumped?.....It couldn't get to the root of the problem.

All laugh

Barney - (*opens mouth*)

Stop laughing and stare at Barney

Barney - No, I got nothing

Pew Pew - Come on then, lets crack on and find some wood, branch out people

Idiots laugh and exit left

Buster, Donald and Snow enter right

Snow - here's some lovely flowers, I'll pick these and hopefully that will be enough

Snow goes to opposite side of stage to pick flowers

Buster - Right Donald, you know what to do, so get on with it, and don't forget we need her hair as proof

Donald - Do we really have to? Can't we just say she escaped?

Buster - Either you do it and do it now, or I'll do away with both of you. You know there's part of me that wants you to refuse, I would quite enjoy doing away with the two of you.

Donald - OK OK, I'll do it, but you go keep look out.

Buster goes off stage right

Donald - Errr Snow, I need to speak with you

Snow - I'm nearly finished Donald, just a few left

Donald - Snow please leave that, I need to tell you something

Snow - Oh my, you look troubled, what's the matter? Is it Buster, is he bullying you? Because if he is

Donald - Snow please listen. Me and Buster have been sent with you today because we are meant to make sure you don't return to the village. We Iam supposed to kill you by order of the queen.

Snow - Oh no, please Donald, don't hurt me

Donald - Of course I won't hurt you, but you need to run away, far away and never return, promise me Snow, you won't return.

Snow - I do promise, but what about Buster? Won't he tell?

Donald - He won't know, I'm supposed to return with your hair as proof, so I took one of Mumsy's wigs, I'll trick them into thinking it's your hair. Now please Snow, go hide

Snow - Oh my dearest Donald, how can I possibly thank you? You are truly very brave

Donald - knowing you are safe is thanks enough, now goquickly, and be safe

Snow - I'll never forget you, thank you Donald

Snow hides off stage left

Buster enters right

Buster - So, is it done?

Donald - *(holds up wig)* yes it's done, how can you be so cold about it?

Buster - Oh cheer up butter cup, it's just another day at the office for me, come on let's get back and deliver the good news

Donald and Buster exit right

Snow enters left

Snow - Thank heavens they've gone, oh what am I to do? Where am I to go? I knew the queen was evil, but I never imagined she would resort to murder.

Song 3

Finishes song and sits crying

Rabbits enter left

Rabbit 1 - Oh look, someone's thrown away a perfectly good young lady

Rabbit 2 - Typical, I hate fly tippers

Rabbit 3 - She's crying, I wonder what's wrong?

(Rabbits sit down next to Snow)

Snow - Oh hello bunnies, please ignore my tears, I need to find somewhere safe to go, don't worry though, you don't need to be afraid or sad

Rabbit 1 - Don't worry about that, it's your problem, we're not bothered anyway

Rabbit 2 - Don't be mean, she needs help and maybe we can be of assistance

Rabbit 3 - No no, never get involved with weepy teenagers, their emotions are all over the place

Rabbit 2 - She needs our help. We can't just leave her

Rabbit 1 - Wanna bet, just watch me

Rabbit 3 - No no Skippy's right, we should help

Rabbit 2 - My name is not Skippy! Just that village idiot says that

Rabbit 1 - Alright..... Skippy..... don't get your tail in twist

Snow - Oh my dear rabbit friends, what am I to do or where am I to go?

Rabbit 3 - let's show her where the idiots live, they seem nice as well as simple

Rabbit 1 - But I've got a carrot at home with my name on it

Rabbit 2 - Come on it won't take long, it's not far

Rabbits grab Snow's hand and try to lead her off stage left

Snow- What is it my friends? Do you want me to follow you?

Rabbit 1 - ***(sarcastically)*** Noooo we want to take you home to make a soup out of you

Rabbit 2 - I thought we were vegetarian

Rabbit 3 - We are, we're being sarcastic you fool

Snow - Thank you my furry friends, probably my only friends now, I will follow you, I trust you

All exit left

Curtains close

Scene 4

Narrator - Our poor Snow White is now fleeing for her life. Persecuted for simply being the fairest in the land.

On a positive note, thankfully Donald didn't go through with the hideous crime and allowed Snow White to escape into the woods. On a negative note, how bad were those tree puns? I get it that comedy isn't the easiest thing to write, but really? Spruce Springsteen? Perhaps he could duet with Britney Sheers, or Kiki Tree.... that one was for the older boys and girls.

Anyway, back to our story, our friendly rabbits have taken Snow into their care and promised to lead her to the safety of the idiots cottage. But will the idiots agree to help her? How will Donald convince the evil queen that a wig is the hair of Snow White? Will Mumsy realise she has a wig missing? What has the man on the 5th row had for his tea? And how did it drip down the front of his shirt?

We'll answer all these questions and more as we return to our story.....

Curtains open to reveal cottage

Dibble, Grub, Dave are busy cooking

Dibble - This is tedious, I'll be glad when we're finished, I hate cooking

Grub - Yeah, we hate your cooking too, but I agree cooking is pants

Dave - Your cooking tastes like your dirty pants. We need a maid or something

Dibble - You're right, someone who can actually cook

Grub - We can't afford a maid, not since we were kicked out of the village and lost our jobs

Dave - We'll return one day, mark my words, and that so-called queen will get her just desserts

Other idiots enter right

Pew Pew - Someone mention dessert? I love pudding

Barney - Since when could we afford a dessert?

McGrew - No one here knows how to make a pudding

Pew Pew - We can't even manage to put a decent main together

Barney - Most of us struggle to make a glass of water

McGrew - Most of us struggle to pass water **(looks at man in audience)** am I right?

Knock at door right of stage

Cuthbert - Who's that? We weren't expecting visitors

Dibble - Maybe it's them people who say if you don't mend your ways, you'll burn in hell's fire

Grub - You mean the eccentric religious ones?

Dibble - No, the fire brigade when they check your smoke alarms

Dave - Well someone needs to answer it, bagsy not me

Knock at door right of stage

Pew Pew - Don't worry, I know how this works, who's there?

Snow- Snow

Pew Pew - Snow who?

McGrew - Snow body there

All idiots laugh

Cuthbert - Or or, **(sings)** Snow business like show business

All idiots laugh

Barney - No no wait, how about..... snow one here but us chickens

Stop laughing and stare at Barney

Barney - Oh come on... how are you not getting these?

Knock at door right of stage

Snow enters right

Snow - Hello, anyone here?... oh hello, I did knock and no one answered but I heard voices

McGrew - No I'm sorry, nobody here

Barney - No one here but us chickens

Snow- Haha that's quite funny

Barney - See, she gets it

Cuthbert - I don't wish to be rude, but who are you?

Snow - Please excuse my rudeness, I'm Snow White, niece of the evil queen

Dave - The evil queen?!!...w.w..what do you want with us?

Grub - We haven't done anything, we promise we haven't

Snow - I'm not here to spy on you, please be calm. I am having to flee from her, she wants me killed. **(starts crying)**

Dibble - What did you do wrong? You must have done something really bad to deserve that.

Pew Pew - We don't want to know, it's best if we don't get involved, nothing good comes from getting involved in the queens business

McGrew - We can't just leave her crying, I don't like it when people cry, it makes me start to **(starts crying)**

All start crying except Cuthbert

Cuthbert - Alright, alright. Can you all just stop right now

All stop crying

Cuthbert - Thank you.... sappy lot. Now young lady, what is it that you want from us?

Snow - I just need somewhere to hide, just until I can decide where to go. I won't get in the way, I promise I won'tI can help cook and clean for you

Barney - Well we could certainly do with help with that, we can't cook or clean

Dibble - You speak for yourself, I'm a very clean person

Grub - You? very clean!! Don't give us that, I've seen you kiss a pigeon on the mouth

Dave - Shut up all of you, we have a decision to make. I'll tell you what we'll do young lady, you finish the dinner off, so we can see how well you cook, then we'll decide if we let you stay.

Snow - Thank you, thank you. Of course I can do that, it's the least I can do. You all go wash your hands and I'll have this finished in no time.
